

The Sixth Meeting of States Parties (6MSP) to the Convention on Cluster Munitions takes place in Geneva, Switzerland from 5 to 7 September 2016.

At this meeting, States Parties to the Convention on Cluster Munitions reported on progresses made in implementing their treaty obligations and the Dubrovnik Action Plan. States not party also provided updates on their positions and plans for ratification or accession of the Convention.

In this important meeting, Laos has given great importance to the Convention on Cluster Munitions (CCM) through the approval of several related regulations, policies, strategies and practices. Led by Director General of International Organization Department, Ministry of Foreign Affairs H.E. Kham-Inh Khitchadeth made the government's reaffirmation when delivering his speech at the 6th Meeting of the CCM in Geneva, Switzerland. The Lao delegation made substantive statements in all key sessions such as: Universalization, Clearance and Risk Reduction, Victim Assistance, International Cooperation and Assistance, National Implementation Measure.

Around 300 delegates have participated in the conference under the chairmanship of Netherland Ambassador Henk Cor van der Kwast.
